Subject: Notifying the Director/Fire Coordinator, Deputy Director of Emergency Services & Deputy Fire Coordinators

Policy 35-a

Purpose: To establish a protocol for dispatching the Director/Fire Coordinator, Deputy Director of Emergency Services & Deputy Fire Coordinators.

Policy: The Director/Fire Coordinator, Deputy Director of Emergency Services and (appropriate) Deputy Fire Coordinator will be activated under the following incident conditions. Their activation is **NOT** optional under these conditions.

*Activate the Director/Fire Coordinator, Deputy Director of Emergency Services and the appropriate Deputy Fire Coordinator using the **FIRE PAGING** folder.*

- Confirmed structure fire that requires mutual aid to the scene.
- An incident involving more than (1) one Fire Department. (Except **automatic** mutual aid calls.)
- **ALL** fatal fires
- Serious injuries to a firefighter
- Whenever a special County team is activated:
 - County Cause and Origin team---Gary Goodrich Car 3 (**notify only**) *See special notification notes below.*
 - County Hazmat team---John Wallace Car 6
 - County Command Vehicle---Peter Alberti Car 5
 - County Accountability system---Peter Alberti Car 5
- When a Fire Dept. contacts OFPC for assistance at an incident
- Upon request by the incident commander

*****Notification of the above staff will be done by fire pager first then if no response use their cell phone*****

Special Notification:

- Notify the Director, Deputy Director and the appropriate Fire Coordinator when a special County team or apparatus is needed. Even when there is no mutual aid dispatched to the scene and the Incident Commander request a special team the Dispatcher **WILL** notify the Director, Deputy Director and appropriate Fire Deputy in charge of the special team or apparatus.
- If the Director or Deputy Director are already on the scene of the incident or M/A fire and the C & O team, Hazmat team or Accountability system is requested you **DON'T** need to dispatch the Director or Deputy Director again.
- If the Deputy Director is on the scene and a special team is requested by the I/C Greene 9-1-1 will notify the Director and the appropriate Deputy Fire Coordinator of the request.
- Car 3 **ONLY** needs to be notified when the C & O team is being dispatched. Car 3 does not need to respond to each and every C & O request. This also goes for the Director and Deputy Director.
