



WHEREAS, the New York State Association of Counties (NYSAC) entered into an agreement for Energy Procurement Services with Municipal Electric and Gas Alliance (MEGA) on March 2, 2011, whereby MEGA offers its existing energy procurement and management programs to all NYSAC members and affiliate organizations; and

WHEREAS, Greene County is an affiliate member of NYSAC; and

WHEREAS, MEGA has negotiated a Commodity Master Agreement between HESS Corporation and the County of Greene for the purchase of natural gas and electricity at a rate which will realize a substantial savings to Greene County over the period of the contract; and

WHEREAS, compensation to MEGA for its services to NYSAC, and derivatively to Greene County, is paid for by a fixed royalty fee by the suppliers of gas and electricity based on the value of sales to participants; and
