



Amending Agreement with Local 968 AFSCME, AFL-CIO, Council 66 Regarding the Temporary Change of Work Hours and Work Days

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 328-12 adopted on October 17, 2012; the Greene County Legislature authorized an Agreement with Local 968 AFSCME, AFL-CIO, Council 66, covering the years January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2014;

WHEREAS, a labor management meeting was held on May 2, 2014 between representatives of the AFSCME Union and the County to discuss a temporary change in work hours and work days from five eight- hour days per week to four ten-hour days per week, in an effort to increase efficiency and reduce expenses; and

WHEREAS, the County and the Union agree that this work schedule, has been implemented since 2008, has proven to be beneficial and cost efficient and they further agree that the same change in work hours and work days from five eight-hour days, to four ten-hour days per week, will be implemented on a temporary basis, effective Monday, June 2, 2014 and continue through Friday, August 29, 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Acting Chairman of the Greene County Legislature be and hereby is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Agreement with Local 968, AFSCME, AFL-CIO Council 66, amending the current contract.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

The County of Greene and AFSCME Council 66, local 968, are parties to a Collective Bargaining Agreement for the term of January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2014.

The County and Local 968, in an effort to increase efficiency and reduce expenses incurred due to the high cost of fuel have reached an understanding concerning a change in workdays and work hours to be implemented on a temporary basis and agree as follows:

1. On May1, 2014, a Labor Management meeting was convened between representatives of the AFSCME Union and the County to discuss a temporary change in work hours and workdays from five eight hour days, to four ten hour days per week.
2. The County and the Union agree that this work schedule has been implemented previously since 2008 and has proven to be beneficial and cost efficient and further agree that the same change in work hours and workdays from five eight hour days, to four ten hour days per week will be implemented on a temporary basis, effective June 2, 2014 and continue through August 29, 2014.
3. The County and the Union agree that during this temporary change regular work hours will be 6:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M., Monday through Thursday and that the Building Supervisors will ensure that the workforce is deployed from the buildings no later than 6:30 A.M., and that work is performed without undue disturbance in populated areas. It is further agreed that work will continue until at least 4:00 P.M., unless it is determined by the Building Supervisor that additional travel time is required to return to the building.
4. The County and the Union further agree that in order to provide coverage on Fridays during this temporary change in work schedule, regular work hours for the two employees assigned to sign maintenance will be 6:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M., Tuesday through Friday.

6. The County and the Union agree that use of benefit time will be required for any time not worked and that a day off will equal ten hours of benefit time.

7. Based on this explanation and our discussion with the Union representatives this proposal is acceptable.

Authorize Contract with Viridian Energy To Purchase Natural Gas

WHEREAS, the New York State Association of Counties (NYSAC) entered into an agreement for Energy Procurement Services with Viridian Energy on May 6th, 2014 whereby Viridian Energy offers its existing energy procurement and management programs to all NYSAC members and affiliate organizations; and

WHEREAS, Greene County is an affiliate member of NYSAC; and

WHEREAS, Viridian Energy has negotiated a Commodity Master Agreement between Viridian Energy and the County of Greene for the purchase of natural gas at a rate which will realize a substantial savings to Greene County over the period of the contract; and

WHEREAS, compensation to Viridian Energy for its services to NYSAC, and derivatively to Greene County, is paid for by a fixed royalty fee by the suppliers of gas based on the value of sales to participants; and

WHEREAS, Greene County wishes to avail itself of the services of Viridian Energy and to therefore contract with Viridian Energy for a three (3) year period for the purchase of natural gas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County of Greene is authorized to enter into a contract with Viridian Energy subject to approval as to form by the County Attorney.
