Authorizing Contract And Appropriating Funds - Greene County Emergency Services - Homeland Security

WHEREAS, The Greene County Department of Emergency Services applied for and was awarded \$436,204.00 from the Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) Consolidation, improvements and Enhancements Grant funding; and

WHEREAS, Greene County also applied and was awarded \$151,468.00 from the Public Safety Points Operations Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency management Agency awarded Greene County \$112,500 for Greene County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Greene County Legislature be authorized to execute a contract subject to approval as to form by the County Attorney, to accept these grants from the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services in the amount of \$700,172.00; and be it further
