Resolution In Opposition To The Elimination Of TANF Non-Residential Domestic Violence Services Funding

WHEREAS, Community Action of Greene County, Inc. administers the Columbia Greene Domestic Violence Program, assisting 1,500 victims of domestic violence served each year; and

WHEREAS, this program serves victims of family violence and their children in both Greene and Columbia Counties; it provides shelter services in each community, along with non-residential services that include 24 hour hotline service, individual and group support counseling for victims and their children, assistance with obtaining orders of protection, assistance navigating the social service system, advocacy and information and referral; and

WHEREAS, the New York State proposed FY 2015-2016 budget completely eliminates the TANF ("Temporary Assistance For Needy Families") non-residential domestic violence services funding; and

WHEREAS, in rural communities such as Greene County and Columbia County, these resources are of huge importance to these victims and their families, and to completely eliminate funding for non-residential domestic violence services in light of this great demand is unconscionable; and

WHEREAS, the demand for non-residential domestic violence services has continually increased since the inception of this funding stream; and this loss of funding will have a major impact on the victims of domestic violence and the programs that provide services to them; and

WHEREAS, non-residential domestic violence services are essential to New York State's response to domestic violence; these services are mandated in every county (per the New York State Social Service Regulation) and include the above referenced services, as well as optional services such as peer support groups, child care and counseling, transportation services for victims to help them access important services, and translation services for non-English speaking victims of domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, the National Network To End Domestic Violence (NNEDV) conducts an annual census of domestic violence services each year and the last census numbers from 2013 show that **New York State is #3 in the country regarding demand for domestic violence services**; and

WHEREAS, the NNEDV 2013 New York State census report showed that in one day, 4,589 victims were served and of those, 2102 were requests for non-residential assistance and services, including counseling, legal advocacy, and children's support groups; on that same day, there were 572 unmet requests for services, with the top cause for these unmet

services being staff availability and funding cuts, including 119 staff positions across New York being eliminated that year, so there were fewer advocates to answer calls for help.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the members of the Greene County Legislature, do hereby vehemently oppose the complete elimination of TANF non-residential domestic violence services funding and we hereby further urge the Governor and the Legislature to continue their commitment to victims of domestic violence by establishing it at the funding level of \$6 million dollars in the FY 2015-2016 state budget; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution shall be forwarded to Governor Andrew Cuomo; Senator George A. Amedore and Assemblyman Peter Lopez.
