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GREENE COUNTY PLANNING ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

Nomination Guidelines

Each nomination should include a descriptive narrative limited to 500 words. The narrative should include as much of the following information as is appropriate:

- 1. Project name.
- 2. Project description and location.
- 3. Starting and completion date.
- 4. Funding Source Community Development funds, special federal grant, Municipal Funds, private sector or citizen contributions.
- 5. Reason for project's initiation.
- 6. Participating groups municipal departments, citizens, private sector, etc.
- 7. Implementation process by which the project was carried out.
- 8. Conformity with local zoning and comprehensive plan objectives; zoning changes, if any, required to implement the project.
- 9. Project's results (preserving buildings or open space, increased housing, expanded employment base, etc.)
- 10. Description of how the project is innovative or demonstrates a new technique or contributes to planning in Greene County.
- 11. Person, group or agency responsible for initiating and carrying out this project.
- 12. Supporting Materials Provide as much back-up materials as possible on the project submission. These include photographs, reports or news articles.
