Authorizing Community Development Loan Homage Restaurant Group, LLC

WHEREAS, Greene County has received a grant from the State's Office of Community Renewal (NYS CDBG Project ME #477ME9-14) for Community Development Block Grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the County's procedure for making loans from these loan funds requires that the Quantum Fund Committee review all loan applications and develop appropriate conditions for each of the loan proposals; and

WHEREAS, the Quantum Fund Committee met on July 1, 2015 and recommended that a loan be made to the Homage Restaurant Group, LLC, a start-up business that will be located on Second Street in Athens.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Greene County Department of Economic Development, Tourism & Planning be authorized to make a loan, subject to the availability of funds, the loan approval requirements and stipulations of the Greene County Quantum Fund Committee, the terms and conditions of the State grant, and approval by the Greene County Attorney, to Homage Restaurant Group, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$25,000; and be it further

RESOLVED, that if, the project is complete, job goals have been met, and the Borrower has complied with all applicable state and federal statutes and program rules covering this project, and the Borrower shall have fully complied with all of the covenants, conditions, and obligations of the agreement executed between the Borrower and Greene County, then 100% of the loan shall be forgiven; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this resolution shall expire on October 15, 2015 and the loan approval thereby be rescinded, unless the Director of Economic Development, Tourism & Planning, in consultation with the Greene County Attorney, thereafter determines that there is sufficient reason to extend the term for loan closing and/or draw down of funds.

WHEREAS, Greene County has identified a refunding of its Microenterprise Assistance Program through the 2015 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program as a community development priority; and

WHEREAS, Greene County has successfully administered microenterprise assistance projects using CDBG funds in the past; and



Authorizing The County To Assess A Posting Fee For 2013 In Rem Tax Proceeding

WHEREAS, New York State requires Greene County to collect Delinquent Taxes owed to the County under Article 11 of the Real Property Tax Law which provides for the foreclosure of tax liens through an action in rem; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with the statute and recent court decisions defining standards of due process, the County incurs costs for posting of notice on all properties where service by mail cannot be effected, and

WHEREAS, Section 1125 (1)(c) of the New York State Real Property Tax Law allows the imposition of an extra charge of \$100.00 against each parcel so posted, in addition to any other charges authorized by Section 1124 of the New York State Real Property Tax Law, and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature believes that the law-abiding citizens of Greene County should not have to bear the costs of collecting delinquent property taxes;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby authorizes, empowers and directs the County Treasurer, to assess and collect a fee of \$100.00 on all parcels in the 2013 In Rem Proceeding which require an additional posting of notice as defined in Section 1125(1)(c) of the New York State Real Property Tax law and that a taxpayer who wishes to redeem his parcel must pay a fee of \$100.00 in addition to the taxes owed on said parcel.
