Greene County Legislature Transportation Advisory Board

The promotion of Greene County Transit as safe, affordable and reliable public transportation for residents and visitors has benefited from a marketing campaign begun in the 4th quarter of 2017 that included two featured billboards, a local radio campaign and newspaper advertising. A dedicated website at GreeneCountyTransit.com contains information on routes, schedules and fares as well as access to mobility management services to assist those in need with solutions to transportation needs. The advisory board is now working to expand routes to CGCC and Columbia Memorial Hospital.



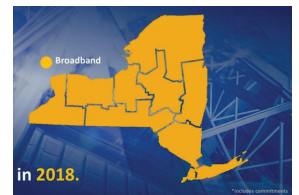

NYS Broadband Round III Awards

Greene County received significant awards in the third and final round of the NYS Broadband initiative. Combined funding for all 3 rounds totaled over \$20,000,000 and is being applied to bring high-speed access to unserved and under-served locations across the county. Recipient ISPs include: State Telephone, Mid-Hudson Data Corp., and Margaretville Telephone Company.
