RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be in effect only after a resolution approving said College Operating Budget has been enacted by the Columbia-Greene Community College Board of Trustees and the Columbia County Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, said Local Law Introductory Number 2 of 2014 is hereby submitted to the Greene County Legislature and is hereby postponed, pending the holding of a public hearing thereon, to the next regular meeting of this Legislature; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Legislature be directed to cause a legal notice of said public hearing to be published in the official newspaper within ten (10) days of adoption of this resolution and at least five (5) days prior to the date of said hearing and to be posted in an appropriate location; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the public hearing shall be held on Wednesday, September 17th, 2014 at 6:20 p.m. in the Legislative Meeting Room, Fourth Floor, Greene County Office Building, 411 Main Street, Catskill, New York.

LOCAL LAW INTRODUCTORY NUMBER 2 OF 2014

A LOCAL LAW IMPOSING AND EXTENDING AN ADDITIONAL MORTGAGE RECORDING TAX IN GREENE COUNTY

BE IT ENACTED, by the Legislature of the County of Greene, New York as follows:

SECTION 1: TITLE. This Local Law shall be titled "A Local Law Imposing and Extending An Additional Mortgage Recording Tax in Greene County".

<u>SECTION 2. PURPOSE AND INTENT</u>. The purpose of this law is to authorize Greene County, pursuant to the provisions of Section 253-x of the Tax Law of the State of New York, to impose and extend an Additional Mortgage Recording Tax.

SECTION 3. IMPOSITION OF TAX. There is hereby imposed and extended, in the County of Greene, a tax of fifty cents (\$0.50) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00), and each remaining major fraction thereof of principal debt or obligation which is or under any contingency may be secured at the date of execution thereof, or at any time thereafter, by a mortgage on real property situated within the County of Greene and recorded on or after December 1, 2014, and a tax of fifty cents (\$0.50) on such mortgage if the principal debt or obligation which is or by any contingency may be secured by such mortgage is less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

SECTION 4. ADMINISTRATION AND COLLECTION OF TAX. The taxes imposed pursuant to this Local Law shall be administered and collected in the same manner as the taxes imposed under subdivision one of Section 253 of the Tax Law and paragraph (b) of subdivision one of Section 255 of the Tax Law. All the provisions of Article 11 of the Tax Law relating to or applicable to the administration and collection of the taxes imposed by such subdivisions shall apply to the taxes imposed by this Local Law.

SECTION 5. REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN MORE THAN ONE COUNTY OR STATE. Where the real property covered by the mortgage subject to the tax imposed pursuant to this Local Law is situated in this state but within and without Greene County, the amount of such tax due and payable to Greene County shall be determined in a manner similar to that prescribed in the first undesignated paragraph of Section 260 of the Tax Law which concerns real property situated in two or more counties. Where such property is situated both within Greene County and without the state, the amount due and payable to Greene County shall be determined in the manner prescribed in the second undesignated paragraph of such Section 260 which concerns

property situated within and without the State. Where real property is situated within and without Greene County, the recording officer of the jurisdiction in which the mortgage is first recorded shall be required to collect the taxes imposed pursuant to this section.

<u>SECTION 6. ADDITIONAL MORTGAGE RECORDING TAX.</u> The tax imposed pursuant to this Local Law shall be in addition to the taxes imposed by Section 253 of the Tax Law.

SECTION 7. DISPOSITION OF TAXES. Notwithstanding any provision of Article 11 of the Tax Law to the contrary, the balance of all monies paid to the recording officer of the County of Greene during each month upon account of the tax imposed pursuant to this Local Law, after deducting the necessary expenses of his or her office as provided in Section 262 of the Tax Law, shall be paid over by such officer on or before the tenth day of each succeeding month to the Treasurer of Greene County and, after the deduction by such Treasurer of the necessary expenses of his or her office provided in Section 262 of the Tax Law, shall be deposited in the general fund of the County of Greene. Notwithstanding the provisions of the preceding sentence, the tax so imposed and paid upon mortgages covering real property situated in two or more counties, under Section 260 of the Tax Law are first to be apportioned by the New York State Commissioner of Taxation and Finance, shall be paid over by the recording officer receiving the same as provided by the determination of the New York State Commissioner of Taxation and Finance.

SECTION 8. PAYMENT OF TAXES. The tax imposed pursuant to this Local Law shall be payable on the recording of each mortgage of real property subject to taxes thereunder. Such tax shall be paid to the recording officer of the County in which the real property or any part thereof is situated, except where real property is situated within and without the county, the recording officer of the county in which the mortgage is first recorded shall collect the tax imposed by this Local Law. It shall be the duty of such recording officer to endorse upon each mortgage a receipt for the amount of the tax so paid. Any mortgage so endorsed may thereupon or thereafter be recorded by any recording officer and the receipt of such tax endorsed upon each mortgage shall be recorded therewith. The record of such receipt shall be conclusive proof that the amount of tax stated therein has been paid upon such mortgage.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Local Law shall take effect on December 1, 2014, provided that a certified copy thereof is mailed by registered or certified mail to the Commissioner of the New York State Department of Taxation and Finance at the Commissioner's Office in Albany at least 30 days prior to the date this Local Law shall take effect. Certified copies of this Local Law shall also be filed with the Greene County Clerk, the Secretary of State, and the State Comptroller within 5 days after the Local Law is duly enacted and this Local Law shall be deemed to be duly enacted upon its date of adoption by the Greene County Legislature.

SECTION 10. EXPIRATION DATE. This Local Law expires December 1, 2016.

WHEREAS, a Project TEP: GREENE COUNTY BLACK BRIDGE/CATSKILL CREEK REHAB P.I.N. 1759.71 (the "Project") is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs such program to be borne at the ration of 80% Federal funds and 20% non-Federal Funds (local); and

WHEREAS, the County desires to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100%, including 80% Federal Funds and 20% non-Federal (local) share, of the costs of Construction and CI;

- 6. The Village of Catskill will repay the County the 20% non-Federal funds estimated to be approximately \$560,000.00 in accordance with the terms of the Promissory Note annexed hereto and made a part hereof;
- 7. Village of Catskill agrees to bond for its portion of the cost, to wit, \$560,000 in a timely fashion so that the County shall receive the Village share of \$560,000 no later than July 1, 2015. Time is of the essence.

- 8. The Highway Superintendent be and is hereby authorized to execute all necessary agreements, certifications or reimbursement requests for Federal Aid and/or Marchiselli Aid on behalf of the County with the New York State Department of Transportation in connection with the advancement or approval of the Project and providing for the administration of the Project and the municipality's first instance funding of the local share of Federal-Aid and State-Aid eligible Project costs and all Project costs within appropriations therefore that are not so eligible;
- 9. A certified copy of the relevant Resolution be filed with the New York State Commissioner of Transportation by attaching it to any necessary agreement in connection with the Project; and
- 10. The Village shall maintain property damage and personal injury liability insurance on this "Black Bridge" as Village property during the term of this contract in an amount not less than \$1,000,000.00/\$3,000,000.00 with Greene County as an additional insured.
- 11. The Village shall be responsible for the maintenance of the Project after completion at its sole cost and expense.
- 12: The Village will defend, indemnify and hold harmless the County, its employees, officers and agents from any personal injury or property damage liability, including reasonable attorney's fees resulting from the Village's performance or failure to perform in accordance with this contract.
- 13. The Village agrees to procure and maintain without additional expense to the County until expiration of the applicable statute of limitations for claims (for contract, negligence or otherwise) against the County and the Village arising out of the Village's performance of the contract. Before commencing work, the Village shall furnish to the County a binder or policy declarations page from their insurance company, showing that these requirements are met. Such binder shall provide (1) that the policy shall not be changed or canceled until thirty (30) days' prior written notice has been given to the County; and (2) that Greene County is named as an additional insured. The Village shall furnish the County with a policy declarations page confirming the County's status as an additional insured prior to this contract being signed.
