## **Narrative**

During the 2022-2023 academic year, the Greene Light to Enrollment Scholarship funded 82 students enrolled in both credit and non-credit courses at Columbia-Greene Community College, bringing the total from the program's inception through the end of the Fall of 2023 to 239 Greene County students who have received \$258,414 in financial aid.

The decision was made in 2023 to offer standard awards of \$1,200 to full time students and \$600 to part-time students. The \$186 fund balance represents the remaining funding from the Fall of 2023 awards season, which was added to the 2024 grant cycle.

Of the original transportation grant made in 2020, the College continues to purchase packs of 80 bus passes to provide to Greene County students facing transportation challenges. These passes are administered through the Dean of Students office.

With gratitude to the Greene County legislators and the taxpayers of Greene County for their continued support of this program that opens the door to financial accessibility to higher education,
