Greene County Receives EPA Grant

On May 20th, 2024, the United States Environmental Protection Agency awarded Greene County a \$1.5 million Brownfield Coalition Assessment Grant, marking the County as one of 29 awardees for this program in the Country. The grant calls for a coalition to be formed that is focused on inventorying, characterizing, and assessing potentially contaminated sites within a specific target area while also deploying preplanning and community engagement activities. The coalition, led by Greene County Economic Development, is comprised of Columbia Economic
