## **FFS: SELF RESCUE**

**Full Description:** This program is designed for firefighter self-rescue based on job performance requirements included in NFPA 1407: Standard for Training Fire Service Rapid Intervention Crews, 2020 Edition. Course content will enable firefighters to recognize the types of events encountered on the fire ground that contribute to firefighter disorientation and/or entrapment, to have knowledge of what is necessary to ensure their safety and that of their partners or crew members, and perform self-rescue techniques when disoriented, separated, or when needing to exit a structure in an emergency. This course requires students to perform several practical evolutions with self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) and includes vertical self-rescue skills utilized for egress from an elevation.
